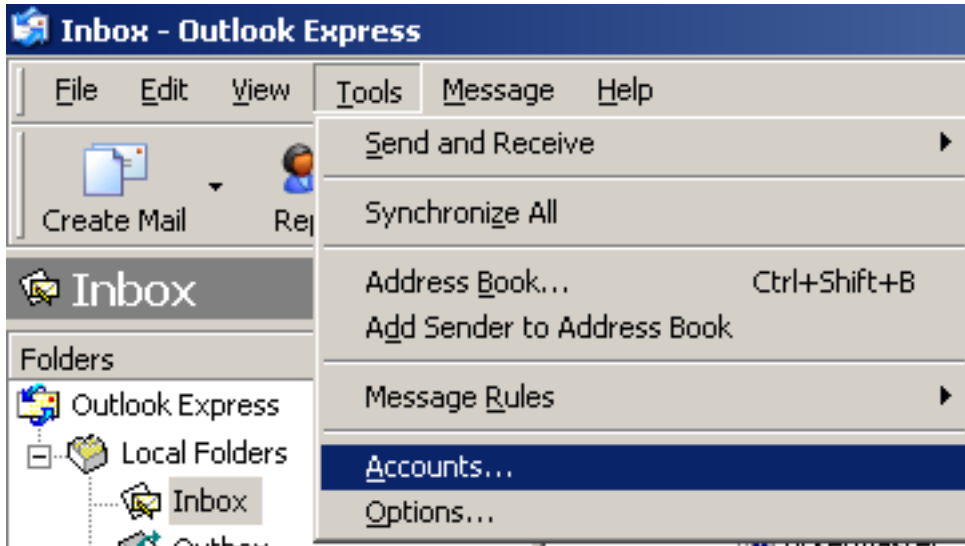
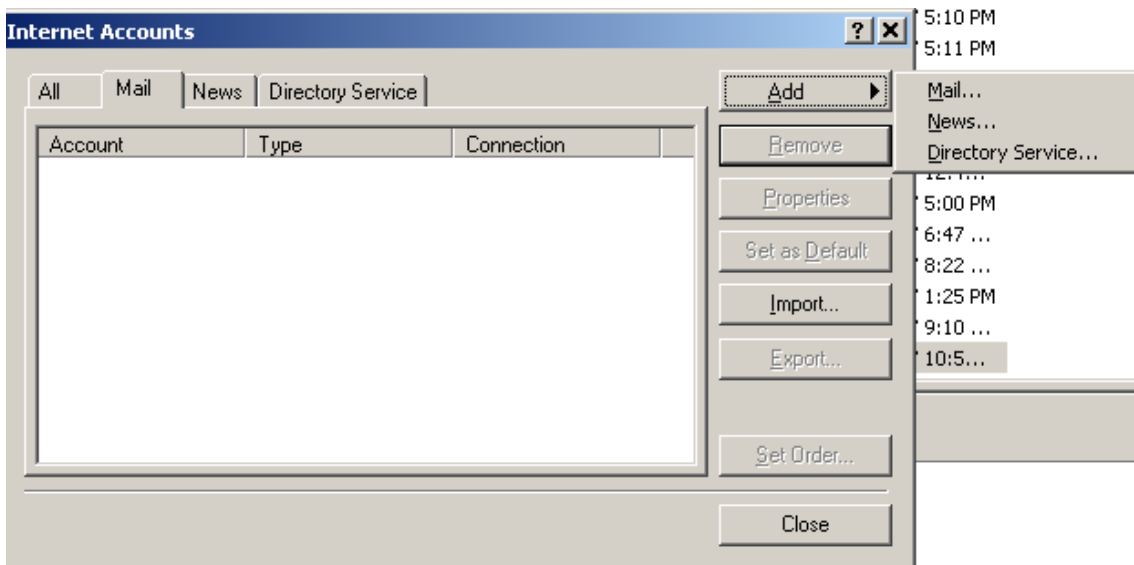


1. Open Outlook Express

3. Click on Add/Mail




4. Put in Your Name

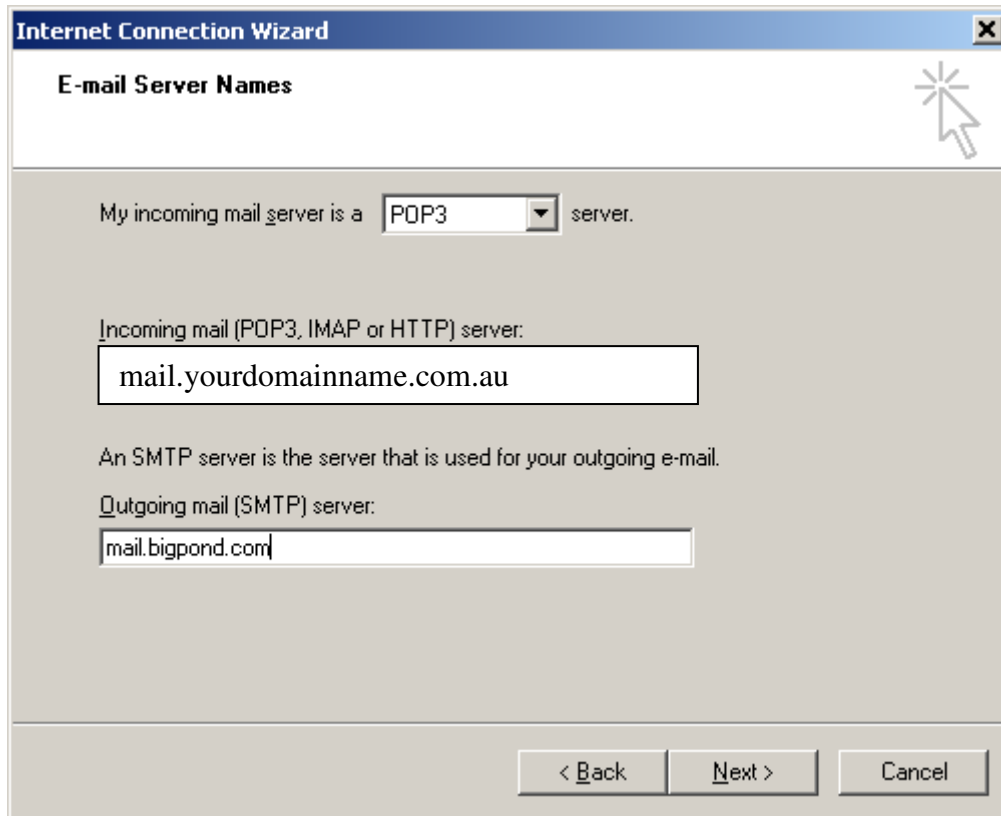

9. Use your existing mail server for the outgoing mail server

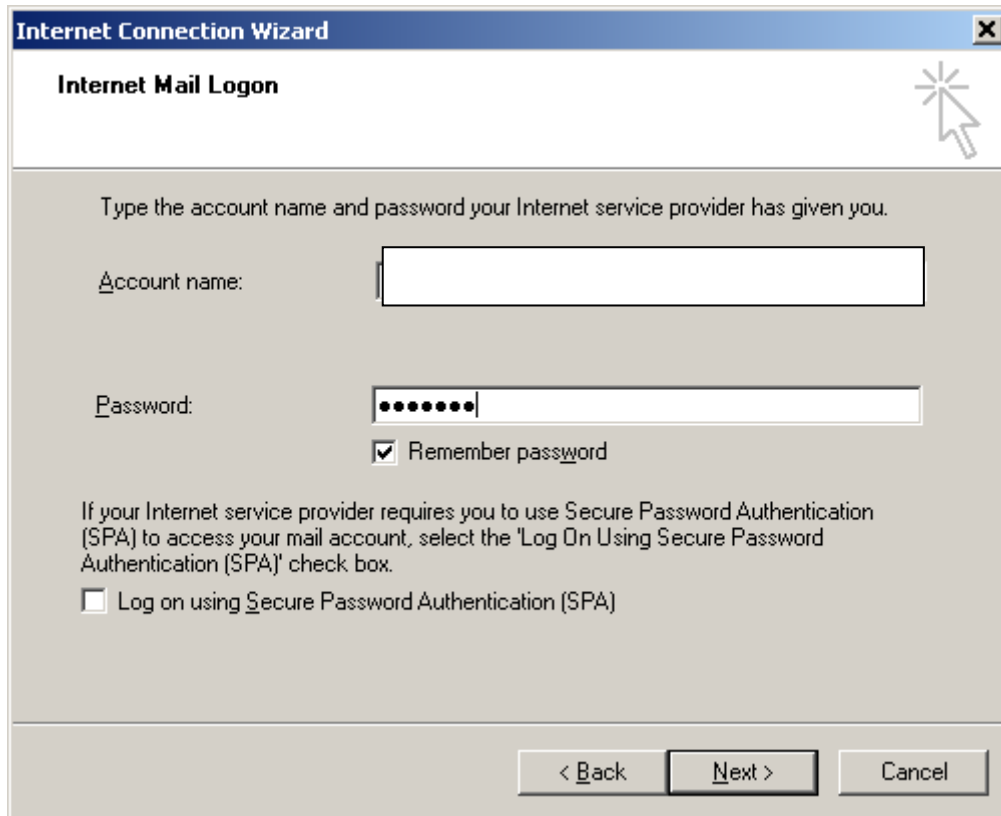
For example if you have big pond as your internet provider, your outgoing mail is mail.bigpond.com
